



The Thaya is in north-eastern Europe, the longest river of the Czech Republic. Its length is 277 km. It is 224 km long and meanders from west to east in the border area between Lower Austria and South Moravia. The Thaya is a tributary of the Danube, which follows the river's course in most parts. Its source is in two smaller rivers, namely the German Thaya and the Moravian Thaya, flowing together at Raabs an der Thaya.
