Best camping is either Nodaway Island (RM 462, left) or at Jentil Breeze (RM 437, left). In town the casino is at the boat ramp (French Bottoms, RM 450, left). There is a buffet and they should let you fill water. I can also arrange for a water drop at one of the other places fairly easily, and inconspicuously. Unfortunately our downtown doesn't have a grocery store near the river, but Atchison does, roughly 4 blocks from the ramp there.

I don't think they have running water. Cooley lake a few miles down from there you can camp. Don't stay at sibley/ft osage if you don't have to. You can camp outside the fence of army corps in Napoloeon. Lexington is a good spot, but no water. There is an old man that comes to the ramp in the mornings in a red pick up, he will probably offer a ride to town for supplies.

Got you covered in kc. Although you'll likely want to blow right through it. 816-288-3885.
